



TODDLER ROOM DAILY ROUTINE

- 8-9 children arrive. Breakfast can be brought in from home and given between 8 and 8.30. Children play in the room.
- 9 Garden is opened for the day and the final children arrive. Free flow between the room and garden. Messy craft in the messy room. Lunches must be ordered by 9:30am.
- 9:45 Children wash hands and sing songs. Weather board is completed before sitting down for snack in the messy room.
- 10-10.30 Children have their morning snack in the messy room.
- 10.30-11:45 Nappies changed if needed. Free flow play continues.
- 11.45 Children wash their hands and sing songs/weather board. Children eat their lunch at 12 o'clock in the messy room.
- 12.30-1 Children go to bed in the toddler room. Non-sleepers play in either the toddler room or messy room.
- 2 Children begin to wake up. Nappies are changed if needed. Garden is reopened for free flow play.
- 2.45 Children wash their hands and have circle time.
- 3 Some children go home at 3, all other children have tea in the messy room.
- 3.30-4 Children play in the room. Some children are collected at 4pm.
- 4.30-5 Any 6 o'clock children have their tea prepared and nappies changed if needed. All other children free play in the room/garden.
- 5 Children are collected. 6 o'clock children join up with the baby room for the last hour of the day.
- 6 Nursery closes.

Children will have Key Person time with their Key Worker throughout the day.
